## The Vale of Evesham Community First Responders

Vale of Evesham Community First Responders is made up of a group of volunteers who use their free time to provide emergency life support to the Wychavon District. They work closely with the West Midlands Ambulance Service (WMAS), and are dispatched to 999 incidents by their control team. The Vale of Evesham Community First Responder team is aiming to provide 24 hours, seven days per week cover for the residents and businesses within Wychavon.
